**Resources Required:**

teaching and hiring qualified teachers wherever necessary. The college administration worked

sincerely on these issues.

**Impact of the Practice:** 

The college was able to complete the syllabi of almost all the departments in time. The students felt good and the teachers had a sense of satisfaction. This practice positively affected the result of the

college also.

Best Practice - II (2015 - 16) Encouraging Questioning and Queries in the Classroom.

**Objectives:** 

Participation of the learners in classroom activities is integral to their effective learning. To promote

this, the college administration decided to promote the culture of raising questions in the classroom.

Context:

It was noticed by the college administration that the teaching – learning activities in the classroom was becoming lecture oriented. The students only keep listening to the lecture of the teachers. No

attention was being paid to clear the sense of doubt in the mind of the students. This was adversely

affecting the learning of the students. The college administration decided to apply a brake on this

practice.

**Obstacles Faced:** 

Owing to the presence of a large number of students in the classrooms, it was very difficult to clear

the doubts of the students. Any attempt to address the need of individual student would distupt the teaching-learning atmosphere of the class. Lack of time and the pressure to complete the syllabi in

time also weighed heavily on the mind of the teachers.

**Resources Required:** 

It was difficult for the college administration to increase the number of classes or provide addition

time for the purpose. Hence, it was decided to make the teachers more approachable for the

students so that they can come to their teachers during any time of the college-hours and clear their

academic doubts.

Impact of the Practice:

Making teachers more approachable for the students created a positive impact in the college. The

students started coming to their teachers to clear their academic doubts. In this way, the students

could be encouraged to ask questions and the classroom teaching was also not affected adversely.

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
