Program Outcomes

English is the most commonly taught and learnt languages of the world. It is an incredibly useful language particularly in the Indian context as it is one of the official languages in India that connects people from across the country. Bachelor of Arts (Core /Honours) in English Literature is planned to provide students with a solid foundation in their language skills. It also polishes their analytical abilities in understanding man and manners. Apart from the canonised British Literature from the 14th century to the modern age, the course includes an in-depth study of English Literatures from across the globe including fields such as Basic Literary Concepts, World Classical Literature in English Translation, Indian Writing in English, American Literature, Popular Literature, Women's Writings, Postcolonial Literature and Nature and Literature in English. The Course encourages a thorough study of all genres of English literature. Through general education, Generic Elective Subjects from other disciplines, Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses and Skill Enhancement Courses and focused study the students are sensitized on issues related to gender discrimination, environment, Indian Constitution and national integration. The course is designed in such a fashion that the students get a chance to develop oral and written communication skills. The presentations and seminars conducted during the study period develop the Information and Communication Technology (ICT) skills among the students. The program also aims at developing individual output, clarity of expression and an ability to communicative.

Program Specific Outcomes
